**Sub : Removal of election related posters, hoardings etc. from inside and outside Court premises and further, prohibiting holding parties/bhandaras inside the court complex, in this regard.**

**FOR IMMEDIATE COMPLIANCE**

**Dear Sirs,**

As per the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, in its judgement dated 19.03.2024 in Writ Petition (Civil) 10363/2021 titled Lalit Sharma & Ors. Vs. Union of India & Ors., erecting hoardings, pasting posters and holding parties/bhandaras with respect to the forthcoming elections to be held by the respective Bar Associations, are strictly prohibited.

Despite the aforesaid restrictions, it has been noticed that there is rampant display of posters, hoardings etc. inside and outside the court premises, holding parties/bhandaras etc. which is against professional ethics and amounts to defying the directions of the Court.

You are, therefore, requested to take necessary steps for removal of these hoardings, posters etc. inside and outside the court premises immediately by issuing necessary circulars/notices, directing the advocates not to resort to erecting hoardings, pasting posters and holding parties/bhandaras etc. In case anyone defies the directions of the Bar Association, the Bar Association may report the name of that concerned advocate(s), with proof to the Bar Council of Delhi, and the Bar Council of Delhi shall take steps for permanent removal of the licence to practice of such advocate(s) and action shall also be initiated for debarring such candidates from contesting the election.
